## OLD BUSINESS

The issue of the number of bowlers on each all-star team was brought back to the table. After much discussion, the following motion was made by Stinky Rowe seconded by Neil Jenkins

There will be 2 separate all star teams. The Senior all Star team which is open to all bowlers 55 years of age, by August 1<sup>st</sup> of the current season and the regular all start team which is open to all bowlers under the age of 55 on August the first of the current season. There are to be 5 bowlers on each team. No one bowler can have a spot on both teams. The team will be selected based on the point system in the operations manual. **Motion Carried**

The Bowler of the year program and the all star team issues were revisited to clarify the timeline and the eligible scores to be used in the process. After much discussion, the final motion made by Troy Platt and Seconded by Earl Riney was as follows:

The scores used for the all-star teams and the bowler of the year selection will be scores bowled during the current bowling season with a cutoff date of March 31<sup>st</sup>. All scores to be considered must come from leagues sanctioned with the CAUSBCBA and Association Tournaments hosted during the current season.

It was also noted that there was a line referencing Averages under the ALL-Star team criteria. This line was removed as it was not part of the procedure put in place.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Robbie brought up the issue of weather or not we wanted to host the state tournament in April/May 2009. After much discussion concerning the working and commitment to the event, a motion was made by Neil and seconded by Cleaster Coates that we bid on the 2009 State Tournament. Motion Carried

We then voted on hosting the Mixed State tournament – a motion was made by Ralph Pridmore seconded by Charlie Crittenden that we host the even scheduled for July 2009. **The motion failed 5-6.**

We then voted on the State Seniors Event – It was noted that the only house that was eligible to host the event was Rice Bowling Center. Don Agreed to host the event. A motion was made by Neil and seconded by Tracy that we submit a bid on this event. **Motion Carried.**

Motion to adjourn was made by Ralph Pridmore seconded by Stinky Rowe Motion Carried
